When can a person receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick? (Part 1)

We considered two weeks ago the question: "What are the effects of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick?" That question generated a lot of interest around this week's very important question: "When can a person receive the Sacrament?" This will have to be a two part answer due to its length. This week we will refer to the Code of Canon Law and give some basic requirements for the Sacrament of the Anointing. Next week we will have specific circumstances.

We read in the Code of Canon Law 1004 §1:"The anointing of the sick can be administered to a member of the faithful who, having reached the use of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age." §2: "This sacrament can be repeated if the sick person, having recovered, again becomes gravely ill or if the condition becomes more grace during the same illness."

We can summarize three conditions necessary for the Sacrament: (1) A baptized Catholic, (2) who has reached the age of reason, (3) and is in *danger* from sickness or old age, or who has become sick again or worsened in the same sickness. Such a person does not need to be in *imminent* danger of death (hence we use the word "sick" rather than "dying"). A person should also be *rightly* disposed. To be rightly disposed means that if a person is conscious of any mortal sin, then that person must go to Confession first and then receive the Anointing.

The sickness in question is in some way life-threatening or it seriously impairs the individual's health. So we ask two questions: "Is there a real chance that this illness could kill me? And, is my health seriously impaired by this illness?" If "yes" then the time for Anointing has arrived.

If a person is unconscious and would have wanted to receive the Sacrament (implicit in this is a desire for forgiveness), then it is given. According to Canon 1005, if there is doubt concerning the use of reason, the danger of the illness, or the status of someone who has recently died (i.e. we are not *certain* that the person is dead), then the Sacrament is to be administered. It is important to note that the Church leans toward giving the Anointing rather than refusing it.

Upcoming RE Schedule


- •The calendar for the 2017-18 RE year is available on the Parish website. The First Day of class for Grades 3-5 and 6 -8 is Sunday, October 1.


