Dear Parishioners:

Well it is my debut writing a Mercy Musings, and as such there are a couple of things to set straight. First, that I foresee that once again Team Healey will be defeated at the Tug-a-war at the Parish Picnic. Second, that I did indeed survive my first week of NFL Football at OLM. Finally, that in a shocking twist, I, Fr. Barrow, came in first during the first week of the Fantasy Football League between teachers, staff, and Fr. Healey here at OLM.

As you know this past week we have been celebrating a Week of Mercy in honor of our Blessed Mother under the title, Our Lady of Mercy. It has been the parish's way of cooperating in this Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy, started by Pope Francis. The year ends on the Feast of Christ the King in November 2016. Of course the call to be merciful never ends, and hopefully this has rekindled vear in knowledge of both God's mercy to us, and of our need to be merciful to others.

On Monday night we Young, welcomed Fr. Adam Pastor of St. Paul Parish in Cranston. He gave an excellent homily and holy hour in which he quoted St. Catherine of Siena who said that God is pazzo d'amore, "crazy in love with us." On Wednesday we performed our Work of Mercy event. We made sandwiches and brought socks for the homeless of Emmanuel House in Providence. It was an excellent example of a coming together, performing and act of mercy, and serving the community. Thursday we had our Back to School Night for parents to give them an opportunity to tour OLM School, to meet with teachers, and to share with them the education and virtue formation we give to their children.

We welcomed Bishop McManus of Worcester to our parish on Saturday evening for the Our Lady of Mercy Feast Day Solemn Mass. Bishop McManus is originally from this Diocese and served as a transitional Deacon here at OLM. It is wonderful to have him back, and particularly to celebrate our Feast day.

We have our annual Parish Picnic from noon until 4pm this Sunday, September 25th at the field behind OLM School. There will be games for kids and adults, music, Pony Rides for the kids, hot dogs and hamburgers, and Ben and Jerry's Ice Cream as well. Please BYO chair, blanket and favorite beverage. Also, bake a homemade dessert for the OLM

Communal Dessert Table. Thank you to all the volunteers who made this event possible.


Finally, we have our annual Blessing of the Pets this coming First Saturday on October 1st at 9:00am.






Classes begin Sunday, October 2, 2016

 2016. 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM. A parent should accompany there child. No Class Grades 3 to 5 that morning.


