Dear Fr. Connors: Why is the family called the domestic church?

The domestic church is a popular way to refer to the family since the time of the Second Vatican Council in the 1960s. The Vatican II

Dogmatic Constitution on the Church, *Lumen Gentium*, declares: "From the wedlock of Christians there comes the family, in which new citizens of human society are born, who by the grace of the Holy Spirit received in baptism are made children of God, thus perpetuating the people of God through the centuries. The family is, so to speak, the domestic church."

The work of the Church—which is to bring about new children of God—relies in large part on the family. Vatican II's *Lumen Gentium* continues: "In [the family] parents should, by their word and example, be the first preachers of the faith to their children; they should encourage them in the vocation which is proper to each of them, fostering with special care vocation to a sacred state."

The family is the place where children come to know God. They are educated in the faith, given doctrinal and moral instruction and taught prayers and Catholic customs. The Christian family reflects the very life of God who is a Trinity of persons in a relationship of self-giving love.

The family, founded on the union of a man and woman in marriage, is an image of Christ's faithful and fruitful love of His Church. The elements of the Church—passing on of the faith, imploring God's mercy through prayer and praise, and works of charity—are all present in the family. The family is the place where most people come to know God and His love, the Church and Her teachings, and experience what a community is faith is all about. It is thus rightly called the domestic church.



Mary, Mother of God



anuary 1 is New Years Day in our secular life, but in our liturgical life, it is the solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God.

In the year 431, the Council of Ephesus declared that the Virgin Mary was Mother of God; in Greek, *Theotokos*, "God-bearer."


Mary was celebrated under this title on the first of January until about the eighth century when the day was changed to mark the circumcision of the Lord.

The reforms of the Vatican II returned the day to Mary, Mother of God but kept the Gospel reading which refers to Jesus' circumcision.
