# Mercy Musings



Dear Parishioners:

Happy Advent! We are one week into the solemn season of joyful anticipation of Christ's coming. How is Advent going for you? Have you taken a little time away from the "mad rush" to Christmas? A little more time for prayer, a little more time for God and a little more time in prayerful preparation is not a bad way to truly prepare for the celebration of Christmas.

In his homily on the first Monday of Advent, Pope Francis recalled that as we proceed towards Christmas, we embark on a journey of faith and prayer in preparation for our encounter Lord. the "Because Christmas," he said, "isn't just a temporal celebration or the memory of a beautiful event. Christmas is something more, Christmas is an encounter with the Lord. And as we make our way towards Him, we must go with open heart and faith, even though this is not always easy in our times."

Pope Francis noted that the Lord does not always say to us what we want to hear, but: "He will tell me what is meant for me, because the Lord does not look at us all together, en masse. He looks each one of us in the face, in the eyes. His is not an abstract love; it is concrete," the Pope said. And "letting ourselves be encountered by God means just this: letting ourselves be loved by God!"

As we continue this season of Advent, we must continue to prepare spiritually for

the of Christ. coming Regular Mass attendance, making a good confession, and making time for daily prayer, can help us prepare the way. Also, in the midst of this very busy and we can truly noisy world "encounter" our loving God with such practices. So this Advent let us watch in hope and wait in faith for the coming of Christ.

A few parishioners have also asked where the large Sacred Heart statue in the vestibule has gone. Well, the statue has been taken out for repair. We are fixing the broken fingers on the statue as well as totally restoring and repainting it to its original condition. The restoration takes a few weeks and I hope to get it back in the new year. Once it is fully restored and the project

completed we hope to find a prominent location for this statue inside the Church.

I hope you enjoyed Dominican Father Michael O'Connor's talk Advent at Devotions this past Monday. We invite you join us again this Monday as our own, Father Connors is to offer a talk on the Christmas Scriptures at Advent Devotions. These Devotions are a wonderful opportunity for us to gather before the Eucharistic Lord adoration and reflect prayerfully on his Sacred Word.

Part of preparing Advent is marking our calendars for upcoming events. I ask you to add the OLM School Pageant to your calendar. It takes place this coming Friday night at 7:00PM in the Church. It is always a festive season celebration of song and music. Our OLM students and been band have diligently practicing and preparing for this big night so I hope you can join us. I know you will truly enjoy it!

This year the Second Sunday of Advent falls on December 8th and as a result the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception has been moved to Monday, December 9th. Therefore, the **Immaculate** Conception is not a Holy Day of Obligation this year. There is a Mass at 7:30AM only for the Immaculate Conception. Have a great week. Enjoy this Advent time of prayer and preparation. Hope to see you at Advent Devotions. God Bless.

Dear Fr. Connors: What are traditional practices helpful to celebrate a fruitful Advent and prepare for Christmas? Is it common to makes acts of sacrifice during Advent as is popular in Lent?



This is a great question. A truly joyful Christmas requires good preparation. What should that involve? Advent has an interesting history in the Church. It certainly is related to Lent, the season of preparation before Easter. The same purple

vestments are worn and a certain sobriety characterizes the liturgy, without use of the Gloria at Sunday Mass for example. Monasteries would still practice some kind of a fast during Advent, although not to the degree of the Lenten fast.

In 1966, the Bishops of the United States explained: "We call upon Catholics to make the Advent season, a time of meditation on the lessons taught by the liturgy and of increased participation in the liturgical rites by which the Advent mysteries are exemplified and their sanctifying effect is accomplished."

It seems the principle preparation for Christmas is one of awakening to what God is doing. We prepare both to celebrate the first coming of Christ at Christmas but also His second coming in judgment and glory. This second coming takes on a personal character for us at our death. The readings at Mass and for the Liturgy of the Hours (the official prayer of the Church) focus in fact on the second coming of Jesus for the first few weeks of Advent.

In so far as acts of self-denial would aid this awakening they could be part of Advent preparation. In the same statement the American bishops went on to say: "We suggest that the devout will find greater Christian joy in the feasts of the liturgical calendar if they freely bind themselves, for their own motives and in their own spirit of piety, to prepare for each Church festival by a day of particular self-denial, penitential prayer and fasting."

The self-denial of Advent though it not exactly the same as Lent. In Lent we join ourselves to Christ's fast for forty days in the desert. We specifically make acts of penance for sin, in reparation for offense to God. In Advent, the self-denial might be more like taking less time for entertainment and more for prayer. The Church's tradition has a rich liturgy in Advent and more deeply entering into that is the best preparation.

Daily Mass would be a wonderful practice during Advent. As would some portion of the Liturgy of the Hours or in a modified form as found in the *Magnificat* publication. Increased meditation on the mystery of God's coming—which may involve self-denial somewhere else—is the best preparation for a holy Christmas.
