Dear Seminarian Nick:

What does your family and friends think of you entering the seminary?



I am very blessed to have an immediate family which is supportive of my entering the seminary but I do have family and friends who are not as supportive. From my own experience there are three categories of supportiveness into which my loved ones fit:

those who are supportive, those who are discouraging and those who treat it as any other job.

I find that most of my family and friends are supportive of me entering the seminary. They know that without the Priest the sacraments cannot be provided to Christ's people. They understand that my entering the seminary is not simply a desire for a job but a perusing of God's calling. Their support of my entering the seminary is not simply because they want me to have a good job, and to be happy, but because they have a love and desire for the Church and her Sacraments.

Those who discourage my vocation are in the smallest group. From my experience, their discouragement is usually caused by some sort of hurt they have experienced from those in the Church. Many people who were hurt or know someone who was hurt by the Church's clergy understandably have a distrust for those studying for the priesthood. I find that those who discourage my entering the seminary usually feel comforted after a good conversation and can even come to forgive those who caused the hurt they or their loved ones experienced.

Those who treat my entering the seminary as any other job training are usually the hardest to deal with because their treatment is usually rooted in a misunderstanding of the reality of the Priesthood. They believe that the Priesthood is not really a bridge between us and God but is simply a public speaking job which puts food on the table. It takes many conversations and even more prayer to help these people understand the reality of the Priesthood and God's love for His people.




