### **The Catechism Corner**

As we celebrate our nation's freedom this week we are also reminded of our own political responsibilities as Catholics. We are

called to bring our Faith into the office, the voting booth, and, yes, even the local coffee shop. To somehow claim that we can be a differ-



ent person in different places YEAR OF FAITH 2012 depending on the expectations of others usually implies a type of "split personality." This, course, requires immediate professional help and cannot in any way be seen as "normal" behavior. "Only the divinely revealed religion has clearly recognized man's origin and destiny in God, the Creator and Redeemer. The Church invites political authorities to measure their judgments and decisions against this inspired truth about God and man." When those political authorities, however, fail to place themselves at the service of Truth, they must be checked. "It is part of the Church's mission 'to pass moral judgments even in matters related to politics, whenever the fundamental rights of man or the salvation of souls requires it. The means, the only means, she may use are those which are in accord with the Gospel and the welfare of all men according to the diversity of times and circumstances." In viewing our religion as an all encompassing practice we realize that we had won true freedom long before July 4, 1776. For a real firecracker, check it out in the Catechism of the Catholic Church #2244-2246.




