Dear Fr. Connors: Do you think modern weapons make the possibility of a just war impossible?

Sound moral teaching forbids the direct and intentional taking of innocent human life.

Such an act is murder and can never be justified. The Church has traditionally identified three areas—self-defense, just war, and the death penalty—as situations in which the taking of human life may be justified.

"The strict conditions for legitimate defense by military force require rigorous consideration. The gravity of such a decision makes it subject to rigorous conditions of moral legitimacy" (CCC 2309). These conditions include: (1) the action represents a last resort, (2) there exist a reasonable chance of success, (3) the action be declared by a legitimate authority, (4) and that the damage inflicted be lasting, grave and certain.

The decision for whether a particular military conflict meets the criteria for a just war falls to those responsible for the common good, namely, the political leaders who have the information and the responsibility to make such a determination.

Because modern weaponry can be so destructive of many human lives—including those of non-combatants—some argue that a just war is now impossible. While I agree that the loss of life of many non-combatants makes the conditions for a just war more difficult, the basic understanding of the just war doctrine remains unchanged. Namely, these are the strict conditions for a just war. Political figures have the responsibility to determine if the conditions exist.

Christians should pray for and work for peace. As Pope St. John Paul II explained, "War is always a failure for humanity." There should be a hesitancy to use military force. However, when necessary to protect the common good—in conformity with the strict conditions of just war doctrine—the possible use of military force cannot be excluded.
