# Mercy Musings



Dear Parishioners:

On Tuesday we celebrated the Feast of Our Lady of the Known for Rosary. several centuries by the alternate title of "Our Lady of Victory," the feast day takes place in honor of a 16th century naval victory which secured Europe against Turkish invasion. Pope St. Pius attributed the victory to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, who was invoked on the day of the battle through a campaign to pray the Rosary throughout Europe.

Pope Leo XIII was devoted to Our Lady of the Rosary, producing 11 encyclicals on the subject of this feast and its importance in the course of his long pontificate. In the first of them he wrote: "It has always been the habit of Catholics in danger and in troublous times to fly for refuge to Mary."

The month of October is dedicated to Mary and her Holy Rosary. The Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to St. Dominic in 1206 after he had been praying and doing severe penances because of his lack of success in combating the Albigensian heresy. Mary praised him for his valiant fight against the heretics and then gave him the Rosary as a mighty weapon, explained its uses and efficacy, and told him to preach it to others.

Since the prayers of the Rosary come from such excellent sources — from Our Lord Himself, from inspired Scripture, and from the Church — it is not surprising that the Rosary is so dear to our

Blessed Mother and so powerful with heaven. If we consider the power of the Rosary as seen in its effects, we find a great abundance of proofs of its tremendous value.

We are blessed in our parish to have many faithful parishioners dedicated to praying the Rosary on a daily basis. Many pray it by themselves and many gather immediately following Daily Mass to do so as a group. These parishioners know well the power of praying the We also gather as a Rosary. parish every Monday night at 7:00PM for October Devotions to pray the Rosary before the Eucharistic Lord.

As Father Connors noted in his homily last weekend Our Lady of Mercy is also truly blessed to have a dedicated group of Rosary makers who meet to pray and make rosaries to be distributed across the globe and here in East Greenwich. Since 2003, this dedicated band of Rosary makers, led by OLM Parishioner Theresa Lee, have made and distributed over 21.000 rosaries for use around the world. They have been especially generous in supplying many of these Rosaries to the missions in Africa and South America. This year they expect to distribute over 1,700 Rosaries. In your name, I thank them for all they do to spread the Rosary here at OLM and to the four corners of the earth!

Dear Fr. Connors: When two Protestants get married is their marriage recognized as a valid Sacramental marriage in the Catholic Church?

All things being equal, the answer is yes. The valid marriage of two baptized Christians is by its nature a Sacrament. That means not even the Pope can dissolve that bond.

Marriage of its very nature is the union of a man and woman bonded together for life. A sacramental marriage—between two baptized persons—is absolutely indissoluble. A declaration of nullity or annulment is a recognition of the Church that what appeared to be a marriage was from the beginning not in fact a marriage. A declaration of nullity is quite distinct from dissolving a sacramental marriage, which is not possible.

Catholics are bound to marry according to canonical form, that is, the form prescribed by the Church. Thus, if a Catholic marries civilly without first seeking the permission of the Church that marriage is invalid. It may be a civil marriage but is not a sacramental marriage. If such a person civilly divorces and seeks to marry in the Church all that is required is to demonstrate that in fact the first marriage was civil and not sacramental. That process simply requires the necessary documentation.

Such a process is distinct from a formal annulment which requires an investigation as to whether a marriage according to proper canonical form lacked some essential element, like the free consent of one or both parties to enter into marriage.

The Church takes marriage so seriously because Jesus takes marriage so seriously. A sacramental bond between two Christians reflects Christ's love for His Church. That love is exclusive, indissoluble, faithful and fruitful. Thus, married love should be too.
