## Mercy Musings



Dear Parishioners:

The new landscaping project got underway this week. The hedges around the property Mercy Park is to removed. receive a landscape redesign much like the front of the Church. This will continue around all the Church property as well. OLM School is to also receive a landscape redesign which removes the larger bushes near the windows as they are a security concern. It's amazing how open and inviting Mercy Park now appears!

As was mentioned last weekend, Fr. Frank O'Hara, one of our Senior Priests of the Diocese of Providence, is with us this weekend. He is here to speak about the very important Senior Priest Retirement Fund Collection. Fr. O'Hara will tell us how this collection serves to support our many Senior Priests. The collection takes place next weekend at all Masses, I speak for all the priests of the Diocese in offering our gratitude for your generous support.

Bishop Tobin has appointed our own Fr. Connors as the Spiritual Director of the Young Adult Family Ministry of the Diocese of Providence. This new position is in addition to his duties as the full-time Associate Pastor at OLM. He is to work with the Director of Religious Education, Ms. Lisa Gulino, and her staff in providing meaningful important ministry to Catholic Young Adults across the state.

In fact, the very first event for Catholic Young Adults and

Young Families is to take place here at OLM on October 1st. Other events include a talk by the outstanding Catholic Evangelist, Matthew Kelly, on October 3rd. And on Wednesday, October 15th Bishop Tobin is to celebrate Mass at OLM and then join in a Question and Answer Session. So if you are a Catholic Young Adult, married or single, in your 20s or 30s please consider coming to these exciting events.

I also received word this week that one of the Deacons of Diocese. Deacon Flanigan, who works with Fr. Shemek in Tiverton is presently in Liberia to help re-open a hospital that closed as a result of the Ebola epidemic. Deacon Flanigan is also Doctor Flanigan who specializes in the treatment of Infectious Disease. He volunteered to go into the midst of a very dangerous crisis, unselfishly giving of himself to help others in their need for a safe refuge should they be exposed to the Ebola outbreak.

Deacon Flanigan has been reaching out for prayers and financial support. I ask you to please pray for him and those who work with him and also pray for all those suffering from this terrible Ebola outbreak. Any financial support you might like to give to Deacon Flanigan's good work can made via OLM Outreach. Any financial support you

give is appreciated and goes to buy much needed supplies to help re-open a hospital and treat the many suffering men, women and children in Liberia. Thank you for your support. In the meantime, please continue to pray for all the doctors and medical personnel helping end this Ebola crisis.

I hope you are planning on joining us at the celebration of our OLM Parish Feast. We begin the celebration next Sunday with the Parish Picnic from 1pm—4pm. It should be a great afternoon of fun with family and friends. Fr. Connors, the Chair of our Picnic Committee, has promised good weather and good times for all Pony rides, tug-of-war, games for kids, food trucks, ice cream, hamburgers and hot dogs and a great time celebrating our OLM Family should make the day a great one for all!

We continue our parish celebration next Monday with a Talk on Mercy by Fr. Chris Mahar (formerly of OLM!) and then a Concert of Marian Music on Tuesday night. On Wednesday, September 24th we celebrate with a Solemn Feast Day Mass at 7:30AM. So mark your calendars and prepare to celebrate.

Dear Father Connors: How do our prayers assist those who have died?

The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains: "All who die in God's grace, but still imperfectly purified, are assured of eternal salvation; but after

death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven." (1030)

This state of purification is called purgatory. It is a sort of waiting room for Heaven. The Church's understanding of this state of purification was influenced by the universal Christian practice of praying for the dead.


Again the *Catechism* explains, "The practice of prayer for the dead [is] already mentioned in Sacred Scripture: "Therefore [Judas Maccabeus] made atonement for the dead that they might be delivered from their sin." From the beginning the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God. The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead." (1032)

The fancy theological word for how these prayers work is the term merit. The prayers and sacrifices (that is, chosen penances like fasting or sufferings born in patience are *offered up*) and then merit—or deserve—grace from God to aid those for whom the sufferings are offered.

Someone prays or suffers and offers that suffering up to God and that prayer merits a grace or help from God for the person in purgatory. The offering of the Holy Mass for a particular intention above all aids the soul suffering in purgatory.

For this reason, we pray for the dead at every Mass and should do so often in our prayers. We can do so for a particular soul or more generally—for all the faithful departed. They are those who were faithful when they died, in a state of grace and thus able to enjoy God's presence after a period of purification. God has designed it such that those united to Him on earth—Christians especially those in a state of grace—can pray efficaciously for those in purgatory.


