Dear Parishioners:

Connors rode his unicycle, the kids enjoyed the pony rides and games, and it was truly a great beginning to the Week of Mercy.

Fr. Connors and over 400 from pilgrims Providence including 20 OLM parishioners departed for Philadelphia for the World Meeting of Families on Thursday. Dear Fr. Connors: What is the origin of the First Friday Devotions? Why do we have an additional Mass and Eucharistic Adoration on that day?

First Friday devotions have their origin in the 17th century in France. There our Lord appeared to a nun named Margaret Mary Alacoque who is now a saint of the Church. At that time an overly rigid view of the moral life was prominent in many quarters of France. People would rarely receive Holy Communion having an impoverished view of God's mercy.

The Lord asked St. Margaret Mary to promote devotion to His Sacred Heart. The statue in our Church and in so many homes and churches was prompted by this increase in devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the 17th century.

One way to promote devotion to the Sacred Heart—that is, the loving and tender and merciful heart of the Lord—is the First Friday Devotion. This devotion was the practice to receive Holy Communion (most often preceded by the receiving the Sacrament of Penance) for nine consecutive First Fridays. The Lord promised St. Margaret Mary that no one who practiced this devotion would die without recourse to the Sacraments.

It is a strong custom in the Church then to offer additional Masses on First Fridays. In has long been the custom of offering a First Friday Mass for the school children here at Our Lady of Mercy.

In addition, we offer exposition of the Blessed Sacrament each First Friday. This devotion is to pray before the Lord in the Eucharist. The Lord is placed in a monstrance, a large gold container where the Eucharist can be seen. Many people come into the Church during the day to pray before Jesus exposed in the Eucharist. At the conclusion of this time of prayer the priest or deacon blesses those assembling with the Eucharist. This is called Benediction.

While exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction can be offered at any time, First Fridays are an especially appropriate time for this devotion.


