Dear Parishioners:

Last weekend, our First Communion and May Crowning celebrations were joyful and faith-filled. Sixty-two of our young parishioners received Jesus in the Eucharist for the first time. It was a wonderful day for the children, their families, and our parish family.

Pray that they and their families remain faithful to the Eucharistic Lord, grow in their love of Holy Mass, and deepen their friendship with Jesus truly present in the Eucharist. As the Angelic Doctor, St Thomas Aquinas teaches: *"The Eucharist is the sacrament of love: it signifies love and produces love. The Eucharist is the consummation of the whole spiritual life."*

The First Communion Class returned on Sunday at the 10:30am Mass for the May Crowning. It was a beautiful way to celebrate Mother's Day and Motherhood as we crowned our Blessed Mother Mary, the Queen of the May! May Mother Mary, our parish patroness, intercede for us and our parish family!

Saint Francis de Sales said: *"Let us run to Mary and, as her little children, cast ourselves into her arms with a perfect confidence."* On Monday nights at 7:00pm, we have May Devotions. After many years of loyal service and faithful dedication to our OLM parish family, they begin a new chapter in their lives. We thank them for all they've done for our parish family, especially for our students. Please pray for them both; may their years ahead be healthy and happy!

Of course, with this change in our Religious Education Program, we begin a search for a new Director. This is an extremely important role in

the life and mission of our parish family, so please pray that we find the best candidate possible!

I thank the over 400 parish families who have made pledges to the Catholic Charity Appeal. Your support this year is truly outstanding. We are well over our parish goal of \$190,000, with over \$250,000 pledged to date.

**May 30 – St. Joan of Arc – Cotignac**

In 1428 the nation of France was in danger of collapsing. The 100 years of war with the English had raged on, and the English were victorious on almost every front. The English set their sights on Orleans, a pivotal battleground. It was then when young Joan, under claims of divine guidance, led the French troops and helped to recapture the cities of Orleans and Troyes and to bring food to those in desperate need. She had become a symbol of hope and faith at a much-needed time.

Joan would be captured by the English and tried for heresy. She was burned at the stake in an untimely death at 19. As she went to hear death, she asked two clergy members to hold a crucifix before her so that it was the last thing she would gaze upon on earth before seeing God face to face. The brutal English would burn her body twice more so that no relics could be had, and no one could say she survived. They reduced her to ash and scattered her remains in the river Seine so that she would be lost forever.

Often, in the city of Orleans, her feast day is celebrated with *pain perdu*, which translates to lost bread; it is the original French toast made without milk. This is served with an Orleans specialty, *Cotignac*, a marmalade made from quince, said to be the first gift presented to Joan when she lifted the siege of Orleans!

**Ingredients**

- 10 quinces
- 4 oranges, peeled, and seeds removed.
- 1 - 2 cups sugar
- 2 tbs Lemon Juice
- Water

**Instructions**

Wash the quinces to remove the 'bloom', then chop into ½ inch cubes and place in a pot. Add the lemon juice. Add enough water to barely float the fruit - at most, barely cover the quinces. Peel, core, and slice quinces. Peel and remove seeds from oranges. Put 4 peeled, sliced, and cored quinces into a pan with water not quite covering them. Bring them to the boil and cook for 30 minutes.

Strain through a colander saving liquid, then squeeze the resulting juice through 2 layers of cheese cloth to extract as much juice as possible. In the strained quince juice cook the other 6 peeled, sliced, and cored quinces, prepared oranges, simmer for 1 hour then press the mixture through a sieve, so as to obtain a thick puree; weigh the puree, add an equal quantity of sugar, return to the pan and cook until the mixture begins to come away from the sides. Remove from heat, allow to cool and store in jars and refrigerate.
