### How does a Christian relax?

Since summer is almost over and usually summer means vacations, trips, relaxation, time off, etc. it seems appropriate to talk about the Christian concept of rest. What is it that we consider rest or relaxation? In order to come back truly refreshed and ready for the task at hand we need to know: what is rest and how is it accomplished?

We do not normally put work and rest together, but this is what Christ does in the Gospel as He says: "Take my yoke/burden upon you...and you will find rest for yourselves." How can we find rest in a burden, especially when the image presented of a yoke or burden evokes the opposite of rest despite Christ's claim that it is easy?

We form two concepts in our mind: Purpose driven activity we call work. Purposeless/Idle activity we call rest. What normally comes to mind when one thinks about work is reading, studying, chores; even praying we might implicitly or explicitly file under the heading "work." Prayer is just another obligation in the long list of things that need to be done. To escape from this and find reprieve we go and rest which involves taking a nap, watching television, going on the internet, playing games and so on. Now these are good things; yet, if these things are rest why is it that these do not really refresh us and instead of helping us to go and work with more enthusiasm and joy, they merely make us hate to work all the more and we strive to return to this so called "rest;" to idleness.

If this is how we separate rest and work, then it seems ridiculous that Christ would put the two together. How can we take his yoke upon us and find rest; Idleness and Purpose do not go together. That is because we have set up a false dichotomy. True rest is not mere idleness.

"...on the seventh day God was finished with the work he had been doing, he rested on the seventh day from all the work he had undertaken." God rested after he ordered chaos, reigned over heaven and earth, and looked and said it is good. Hence true rest is the result of ordering chaos; of making things as they were intended to be. So rest is an activity in which one's highest purpose is fulfilled. Further, in the Old Testament the Temple was where God rested. Now we have been made Temples, where God takes up his abode and rests in us precisely because he has ordered the chaos of Original Sin in our souls and made us who we were truly meant to be through Christ and the sacraments.

The most restful activity, therefore is the Mass. In the Mass is where Christ bids us come, be refreshed, be rightly ordered, be who you are truly meant to be; and all of this is easy; there is no real toil; (the real toil is what we do to get here; to cross the threshold and overcome our own imperfections). If we are not refreshed by the Mass, this is more than likely our fault, and our misunderstanding of rest. It is up to us with God's help to reorient our perspectives and order our lives so that we begin to see and really feel the Mass and worship as founts of refreshment and relaxation.
